

The Chairman of Ajara AR Government Levan Varshalomidze, along with the Minister of Education, Culture and Sport of Ajara Gia Abuladze has awarded 8 graduates of textile products specialty from the Vocational College Black Sea, who have already been employed at AJARA TEXTILE.

"This is a good example of government and private agencies' work together. We have taken responsibility to repair the building where the college is located, processed training programs based on market requirements while private investors facilitated their employment. Tailors needed 3-year training to master in the Soviet period. Now it is possible for several months only, that provides opportunity for employment in extremely short period of time", said Levan Varshalomidze.

Memorandum of Cooperation between Vocational College Black Sea and Ltd AJARA TEXTILE was signed in February 15, 2012. The college has taken responsibility to train 60 specialists of textile products within the short term program.
