

On 22 June 2017, ICC Georgia held its General Assembly at Holiday Inn Tbilisi to elect two Board members and one Second Vice-Chairman Treasurer for a period of one year. Mr. Fady Asly- Chairman of ICC Georgia welcomed the attendees and presented a synopsis and a brief overview of ICC Georgia's achievements for the past two years. 3 candidates were running for the two vacant positions on the Board.
